The Center has three (3) locations at:

- Bellevue Hospital on the East Side of Manhattan
- Gouverneur Healthcare Services in Lower Manhattan
- Elmhurst Hospital in Queens

Note: You do not have to speak English. You will be able to speak with someone in your own language. You can get treatment even if you cannot pay or do not have health insurance. Available to people who lived in Lower Manhattan or areas of Brooklyn, were attending school in the area, were working in the area or helped in the clean-up of the affected area.

- Register with the New York State Workers' Compensation Board by August 14, 2008
- To protect your right to file for 9/11-related worker's compensation if you become sick in the future
